Half of the money raised from Sulgrave Fete was given to maintain and improve the facilities of the Pocket Park in Sulgrave.

To conform to Health & Safety regulations, we will need to spend a proportion of the money to replace the safety surface in the play area and the Parish Council have already obtained a small contribution from Northamptonshire Council to help towards this cost.

In order for the children to use the park to its full potential during the summer months, it will also be necessary to arrange more frequent grass cuts.

However, there will still be a sum of money (approx £1500) available to use for park improvements and YOU can help decide what these improvements will be.....
